

PERMISSION FOR UNATTENDED CHILDREN

For the 2010 season, the following policy applies to children at the pool. This applies at all times, including during general pool hours, swim and dive team practices and meets, and lessons.

Children who have not reached their 7th birthday must be supervised by an adult (age 14 or older) who stays with the child at all times.

Children ages 7, 8 and 9 (between their 7th and their 10th birthday) **must be supervised by an adult (age 14 or older) who stays with the child at all times, unless** you have filled out and returned the permission form below. Return it with your dues notice or to the pool manager at the front desk.

Please be aware that at the discretion of the lifeguards, your child and/or guests may be required to pass the 2010 "tadpole" swimming test.

2010 Parental Permission for Children Ages 7, 8, and 9

The pool management, pool staff, and Board of Directors take no responsibility for supervising children and recommend that you do not leave your child at the pool unattended. The Club is not liable in case of injury.

I understand that the job of the pool staff is to monitor water safety in the main pool, and that neither they nor anyone else is responsible for monitoring water safety of children in the baby pool, supervising any children in the main pool area or elsewhere on pool property, attempting to keep children within the pool area, watching over children who leave the pool, or preventing any child from leaving the pool property, attempting to stop any children from playing on the bridge or in the stream, or supervising them in any other way. I understand that this policy applies at all times of pool operation, including during general swimming, lessons, and swim and dive team practices and meets.

My child and I have made plans for what my child is to do if the pool closes suddenly due to a thunderstorm or any other unexpected event such as sanitation or chlorine problems and understand that closings occur frequently. We understand that the pool staff is not responsible for taking care of the children and that the staff may lock up the pool area and leave when a thunderstorm or other unforeseen event occurs, even if this means leaving children unattended outside the pool area.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, I hereby release the Club, pool management, pool staff, and the Board of Directors and officers of the Club from any and all liability relating to or arising from any injury or damage that may occur to my child during any time at which my child is at the pool.
